Place: The Norman Lehr Center in Melvin Price Memorial Park

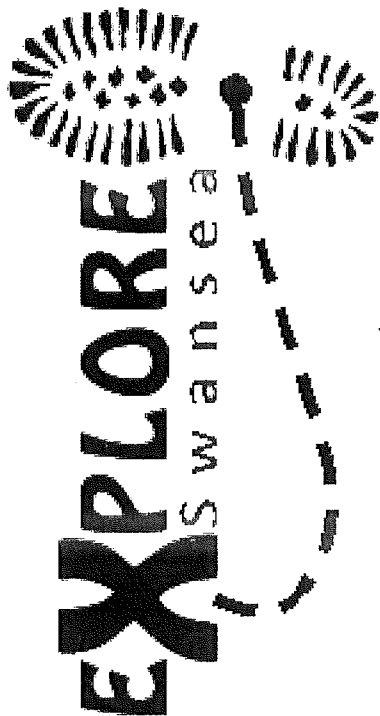
