Obey Traffic Laws Re: School Buses

School's will soon be back in session so drivers should be extra alert for students crossing roadways, walking to school, or waiting at bus stops.

Each year the Village also reminds driver's about traffic laws related to school buses.

Flashing red lights on a school bus and an extended stop sign mean that drivers on a two lane road are required to stop when approaching that bus from either direction. It is unlawful to pass that stopped bus.

When a bus is stopped on a multi-lane roadway like IL Rte. 159, drivers traveling in the same direction as the bus are required to stop. In this case, drivers headed in the opposite direction are not.

SUMMER USAGE DEDUCTION FORM

Apply For Summer Usage Deduction

Swansea residents who do not use a deduct meter may still apply for a sewer bill credit to offset charges for water usage that did not enter the sanitary sewer system. This usage typically occurs during the summer with watering lawns, plants and filling swimming pools.

The credit is based upon the difference between the average water consumed on the first two bi-monthly sewer bills issued after May 1st, and the average water consumption reflected on the four bi-monthly sewer bills immediately preceding that same May 1st.

Fifty percent (50%) of the difference between the average consumption for the 'winter' and 'summer' periods is then subtracted from the user's actual water consumption on the next bill. Sewer charges are then calculated on the resulting balance.

To apply, complete the form to the right and mail or drop off as indicated. You must reapply each year, the deadline to apply is Oct. 15th, and you must have lived at the property for at least one year. Those who use a deduct meter are allowed to deduct 100% of the readings through that meter.



Consider Option For Automatic Electronic Sewer Payments

There are multiple ways to pay your sewer bill, but the most convenient way for our customers may be an option to authorize the Sewer Billing Department, via an authorization agreement, to automatically withdraw funds from your checking account for payment of your Swansea sewer bill on the due date.

Those who take advantage of this program still receive a bi-monthly bill, however, it would now indicate that the payment will be paid electronically, and automatically withdrawn on the due date.



Old Town Swansea Pop-Up Bike/Walk Event

Residents and visitors of Swansea are welcome to attend this walk and bike ride on Saturday, August 10th beginning at 9 AM to 11 AM at the Swansea MetroLink Station. This will be to identify potential streetscape improvements that could be part of the Old Town Streetscape Master Plan. Attendees will walk, ride, or both in a 1-mile loop (or shorter if you choose) to test out bike paths, sidewalks, multi-use paths, and other enhancements to the streets around the MetroLink Station. Guests are encouraged to provide feedback about what they like and don't like, challenges, and ideas. It is an opportunity for residents to learn about possible infrastructure enhancements for walking and biking and try them out. This is an activity for all ages and refreshments will be provided.

The route begins at the MetroLink parking lot. Participants will travel east on Metro Way, where different types of bike lanes will be temporarily added to



the street. Walkers will use the sidewalk. At Illinois Street, participants will use the crosswalk and signal to access the sidewalk on the east side of Illinois Street, then travel north. The sidewalk will be marked as a multi-use path and they will be able to test sections of path buffered and not buffered from the street. Participants will use the signalized crosswalks to

cross both Fullerton Road and Illinois Street and then continue west on Fullerton Road on the sidewalk. To complete the loop, they will turn south onto Metro Way and finish at the MetroLink Station. Two staff members will be stationed at the Metro Link Station for the event with additional staff at each turn to guide participants and collect feedback.

Fire Dept. Urges Fire Safety In Summer

With summer months always come outdoor cookouts and barbecues. The Swansea Fire Department has a few tips to make sure you stay safe while enjoying your time with friends and family.

Barbeque Safety Tips

- Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors to prevent any carbon monoxide build up in an enclosed area.
- The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Keep children and pets away from the grill area.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill.
- When starting a gas grill, open the tank valve to full to light the grill then back off 1/4 turn once lit.
- Never leave your grill unattended.

Home Fire Safety

- Have a working smoke detector in every bedroom and at least one on every level of the residence.
- If you need assistance with smoke detectors, please contact the Swansea Fire Department for installation of up to three (3) 10 year smoke detectors at no cost.
- Illinois state law requires a working carbon monoxide detector within fifteen (15) feet of every occupied bedroom.

- Test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors on a monthly basis to make sure that they are working properly.
- Replace carbon monoxide detectors every five (5) years from the date of manufacturer and replace smoke detectors every ten (10) years from date of manufacture.
- Never leave lit candles unattended.
- Summertime Burn Safety
- Wear short sleeves or roll them up when cooking on the grill.
- Use long-handled barbecue tools.
- Keep a 3-foot safe zone around grills, fire pits and campfires.
- Attend public fireworks displays; this leaves the lighting to the professionals.

Campfire Safety Tips

- Always follow the campfire rules for the area where you are camping or living. Some parks and towns prohibit fires, and these rules are there for a reason. Check the local regulations before you build your fire.
- Do not store gasoline, liquid fire starter, or any other type of flammable liquid near the campfire. It's too easy for stray flames to ignite these materials.
- Do not build large campfires, even if they seem impressive. It's much safer to keep fires small so they are easier to control.

2019 Swansea Police And Fire Youth Academy

The Swansea Police and Fire Youth Academy has been held for four years now. This incredible and educational program is made possible through generous sponsors.

Thirty-five children attended the 2019 Academy and all of them had a great time. Many officers, firefighters, trustees, Rotarians and others volunteered their time. A special thanks goes out to Police Sgt. Scott Lieb and Fire Captain Jason Whitaker.

In the last four years, almost 165 youths aged 9 to 13 have attended the event. The Academy is three days of highly intensity training, team building, civic and government learning and fun. The children participate in programs for crime scene investigation, police K-9 units, tornado trailer, special response team (SRT) demos, car fire and extrication, helicopter landing, firearm safety, tour of the jail and discussion with an inmate, close interaction with police officers and firefighters from Swansea, disaster and emergency preparedness, civic and government responsibility, team building sports, American flag raising and lowering, proper disposal of an American flag, and community service projects.

Participants also created a self-awareness essay on what they learned. The Swansea Police and Fire Departments, as well as the Swansea Rotary Club, understand that close interaction with police officers, firefighters and government officials are needed now more than ever. Trust and understanding of government is critical for our society to move forward through what can be difficult times. There is also a significant decrease in younger people volunteering their personal time for the benefit of a community. Through donated hours and positive interactions with the Rotary Club the hope is that students at the Academy will appreciate how important their volunteered time can be.


