**REFERENCE THE COMMUNITY CALENDARS ON PAGES 10 & 11 TO REFERENCE EVENTS, IMPORTANT DATES AND MEETINGS.**

The Village of Swansea has committed itself to be a leader in providing multimodal transit options to the residents and visitors of the Village, and has further embraced a 21st century approach to project development. The Boul Avenue Trail and Trailhead park has created an excellent connection for the residents of Old Town Swansea and the students of High Mount School. School children were walking along the shoulder of Boul Avenue and crossing the street at random locations to access Mel Price Park for after school ball practices, and the adjacent subdivisions. The Village and their partners have ensured that both the school children and the nearby underserved segment of the community can safely access education, shopping, the Metro Bus system, the MetroBikeLink, and Metrolink.



The Village leadership has taken a stance to redevelop Old Town Swansea, this vision and leadership has been exemplified by the Boul Avenue Trail and Trailhead project. Over the past several years the Village of Swansea has partnered with High Mount School, Bi-State

Development, St. Clair County, the St. Clair County Transit District, and the Illinois Department of Transportation in the development and implementation of the Boul Avenue Trail project and the Boul Avenue Trailhead Park project. These simultaneous projects, which involved funding from both a EWGW/federal TAP grant and a local MEPRD grant are the epitome of collaboration. In addition, to the aforementioned project partners,

the Village worked with the Army Corps of Engineers and the Illinois Department of Natural Resources Office of Water Resources to develop the park project adjacent to the 1% annual chance regulatory floodplain and complied with all Local, State, and Federal Laws.

To further the multimodal developments in Old Town Swansea the Village has applied for grant funding to construct a new pedestrian crossing at IL Rte 159 and Boul Avenue, and is preparing a grant to construct sidewalks along the west side of IL Rte 159 from Boul Avenue to IL Rte 161.

If because of job loss, illness, or some other reason, you may not be able to provide Christmas gifts or a decent meal for your family and could use some assistance, please let the Village know.



# NOTICE OF ELECTION: Consolidated Election For

The Consolidated Election, which is to be held on **Tuesday, April 6, 2021**, will include the election of specific offices in the Village of Swansea. The offices to be filled and the names of the current office holders are outlined below:

## President of the Board of Trustees

One position to be elected, with a four-year term and current annual salary of \$15,000. The current President of the Board of Trustees is Michael Leopold.

## Village Trustee

Three positions to be elected, each with a four-year term and a current annual salary of \$7,200. Current trustees with terms expiring on May 1, 2021 are Matthew Lanter, Richard "Rocky" McDonald, and Brian Wells.

## Village Treasurer

One position to be elected, with a four-year term and current annual salary of \$7,200. The current Village Treasurer is John Walter.

## Village Clerk

One position to be elected, with a four-year term and current annual salary of \$7,200. The current Village Treasurer is Lauren O'Neill.

## IMPORTANT DATES

The first date to circulate nominating petitions is **September 22, 2020**.

Candidates must file petitions and all related documents at the office of the Village Clerk no earlier than **December 14, 2020** and no later than **December 21, 2020**, between the normal hours of the Swansea Government Center of 8:00 am and 4:30 pm, provided, however, that on **December 21, 2020**, the

Office of the Village Clerk will remain open until 5:00 pm.

The Swansea Government Center is currently located at 1444 Boul Avenue, Swansea, IL 62226.

On **December 14, 2020**, the lobby at 1444 Boul Avenue, Swansea, IL will be opened to the public prior to 8:00 am. Per the Illinois Election Code, everyone in the lobby at 8:00 am and filing a petition for the same office, will be considered as filing simultaneously.

Also, per the Illinois Election Code, the order in which candidates will be listed on the ballot for the same office is determined by the order in which petitions are filed. In the case of simultaneous filings, a public lottery to determine ballot position will be held in accordance with the Illinois **Election Code, at 5:45 pm on December 21, 2020**, in the Village Board Meeting room, at the Swansea Government Center, 1444 Boul Avenue, Swansea, IL.

## IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

Every candidate or potential candidate is responsible for securing a copy of the "**State of Illinois Candidate's Guide 2021**", issued by the State Board of Elections, and making themselves familiar with the requirements and process of running for public office.

This guide contains all required forms for the offices to be filled in the Village of Swansea, as well as instructions for their completion.

The guide also contains forms and instructions for other elections and public bodies unrelated to the Village of Swansea and its election. It is the responsibility of each candidate or potential candidate to know and understand which forms are required and which forms to complete and file.

An electronic version of the "**State of Illinois Candidate's Guide 2021**" may be found on-line at the link <http://www.elections.illinois.gov>. Under the "Trending Documents" section on the upper right side of the webpage, click "View All Top Documents" and then select "**2021 Candidates Guide**". Select it again to download a PDF copy of the guide and either print it or save it to your computer.

One hard copy of the Guide will be available for review at the Swansea Government Center during normal hours - at 1444 Boul Avenue, Swansea, IL 62226. Please call the Swansea Government Center at (618) 234-0044 to schedule an appointment to VIEW the guide.

**Specific provisions to note within the Candidate's Guide include, but are not limited to:**

The preface of the Guide recommends that prospective candidates consult with competent legal counsel when preparing their nomination papers.

Page 18, specifies the first date to circulate petitions as **September 22, 2020**.

Pages 15 through 21 outline the instructions for Filing For Office to include but not limited to:

1. General Filing Information
2. Petition Preparation & Formatting Petitions – SBE Form P-3 for an independent candidate or SBE Form P-8 or SBE Form P-8A for candidates of a new party
3. Signing and Circulating Petitions
4. Statement of Candidacy - (SBE Form P-1B for an independent candidate or SBE Form P-1D for candidates of a new party)
5. Statement of Economic Interests Receipt- The “Statement of Economic Interests” forms are available at the St. Clair County Clerk’s Office. This form is filed with St. Clair County, and the receipt from the filing is submitted to the Village of Swansea. Please see more details about filing and when receipts must be filed on page 21;
6. Loyalty Oath (optional) – all candidates (SBE Form P-1C)

7. Campaign Contributions – The Village of Swansea will provide a notice of obligation to comply with the Illinois Campaign Financing Act form after filing via mail (page 21).

Pages 29 through 30 details the form number information, qualifications, residency, and petition signature requirements, depending upon whether the candidate represents a new political party, or is an independent candidate.


Note that for Independent Candidates there is both a minimum number of signatures required and a maximum number of signatures allowed on nominating petitions. Based upon the official Abstract of Votes for the Village of Swansea on file at:

There were 1,244 ballots cast at the last regular election held on April 2,

2019. Not less than five percent (5%) of those ballots are 63 and not more than eight percent (8%) of those ballots are 99. However, since the Illinois Statutes require a difference of at least 50 between the minimum and the maximum, for the Consolidated Election on April 6, 2021, the minimum number of signatures required on nominating petitions for Independent Candidates is 63 and the maximum allowed is 113 (63+50).

Page 62 – 66 provides information for frequently asked questions. There are links within the Guide for the applicable forms.



### Use Caution When Buying and Selling Items Through Social Media Sites

Swansea is a very safe place to live, work and play. We have amazing bike trails and phenomenal parks, in fact, some of the best in the entire state. But, Swansea is no different than any other town, village or city in the St. Louis Metro East area...we have our crime problems. Statistically the crime rate is very low especially with one of the lowest crime rates in the area. My opinion is this is mostly due to the great residents we have. Many residents watch out for their neighbors and call us when anything suspicious happens. That's what good neighbors are supposed to do.

Recently we had an armed carjacking near Green Haven in Swansea. A female had placed her vehicle for sale on Facebook Marketplace. Two males arranged to test-drive the vehicle and came to her house. She got in the car with them and one of the males held a gun to her head and forced her out. There are more details to this and we are very sure it was a traumatizing event for this young lady. We tell you this story to give you simple tips on how to avoid this:

Never, ever sell anything at your house where people come over that you do not know.

Arrange to meet them at the Swansea Police Department parking lot. It is all under video surveillance. Bad guys don't like to go near cops. Especially us.

Bring a friend. A big one if you can. Maybe someone who lifts weights or looks mean. A mother-in-law will do.

Stop in our lobby and let us know first and we will provide extra eyes and ears to watch. An officer might even be on the parking lot.

If they do not show up for the arranged meeting or are hesitant... well then you have your answer!

Understand that virtually every out-

of-area buyer is a fraud. Guaranteed.

Don't give out your personal information.

Don't accept checks or money orders...they can easily be faked.

Don't accept partial payments.

If the potential buyer wants time to consider and comes back later, follow the same procedures. Don't get careless the second time around and let your guard down.

### If Your Sewer System Backs Up, Call The Village First

A friendly reminder to residents: call the Village first if your sewer system starts to backup.

Because storm water can infiltrate the sanitary sewer system during periods of heavy rain, that additional water can overload the system and cause it to slow down or backup. It generally will do so into low lying basements. Residents who have experienced that before probably recognize the signs, or have installed a check valve to prevent backups.

On non-holidays, Mon - Fri, 8:00am - 4:30pm, call 234-0044, and Government Center staff will dispatch Public Works. After hours and on weekends, call 233-8114. A police dispatcher will answer, but explain that you need Public Works to respond to a sewer backup and they will route your call or message.


