Leaf Burning Resumes March 15th

Leaf Burning will resume March 15th through May 15th on Wednesdays and Saturdays only from 9 AM to 6 PM. Burning is not allowed on Village streets or within the Village right-of-way. Fires must be attended and kept under control at all times.

Should the weather be excessively windy, conditions be wet, or air forecasted to be Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups (101 – 150) or higher as determined by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency dates above, burning on said dates shall not be permitted. In the event of such conditions, the Village will post its determination on the Village's website, and send a Code Red alert to residents registered for such alerts. However, it shall be incumbent on anyone intending to burn yard waste, to first reference the Village website for any such notice.

While the Village makes this temporary allowance, all residents should consider the impact, burning yard waste might have on their neighbors. Those with asthma or other respiratory issues can be significantly affected by smoke.

Village Organizes Memorial Tree Program At Melvin Price Park

Swansea residents may be aware of the newly constructed Fitness Trail and Exercise Equipment Area at Melvin Price Park. During construction contractors removed large quantities of dead and diseased trees. With the construction project complete now is your opportunity to help beautify this area of the park while memorializing a loved one. The Melvin Price Park Fitness Trail Memorial Tree Program allows for the purchase and planting of a tree, shrub, or perennial plant in this beautiful park setting. A memorial tree or plant is a living remembrance of a loved one. It provides a sense of belonging and community. They improve the quality of life for residents of Swansea, while providing a benefit and enjoyment to people who use Swansea parks. In addition, trees are a growing and living symbol of the individuals they represent. A memorial tree is a wonderful honor for the individual or organization to make in someone's name and it is a gift that keeps on growing and giving to the community.

Village staff, with input from the

Heartlands Conservancy, has selected native species and have selected locations that are proper for each variety, which include Flowering Dogwood, Redbud, White Oak, Bald Cypress, Oakleaf Hydrangea, Sweetbay Magnolia, Purple Coneflower, New England Aster, and many more species. Memorial Trees and Plants will be planted in spring and fall, and after planting will be watered, pruned, and mulched by Swansea Public Works Staff and volunteers. In addition, during the design of the Melvin Price Fitness Trail and Exercise Area a special section was identified that will serve as a memorial garden specifically for pets.

Forms for this program can be found on the Swansea website, social media, and at the Village Government Center. The cost for Memorial plantings ranges from \$45.00 to \$150.00, and memorial plaques will be placed with all plantings. Donations in lieu of a planting can also be made.

Trash Sticker Price Increase/ Yard Waste Begins

NEW PRICE ALERT!

The price of Trash Stickers will increase as of **May 1st, 2021**. Weekly Trash Stickers will increase in price from \$22.45 per sheet of five stickers to **\$23.35**. Any stickers purchased at the current price will still be honored if used beyond May 1st.

Yearly Trash Stickers will increase in price from **\$247.06 to \$256.94** on May 1st. Thereafter, the cost for the annual sticker is reduced on a pro rata basis by **\$4.95** each week, until the stickers expire on April 30, 2022. That way, someone purchasing an annual sticker after May 1 only pays for that portion of the year they are actually have the service. New annual stickers will not be available until the last week of April 2021.

Republic yard waste services will begin in April. Yard waste prices will increase to **\$12.49** and are billed on a quarterly basis. Yard waste services require a minimum commitment for three months.

Derelict Vehicles In The Village



Village codes prohibit any vehicle from being parked on a surface that is not an "improved surface". The definition of improved surface basically means that vehicles cannot be parked on a grass or dirt area. The code also prohibits the storage or abandonment of inoperable vehicles. Vehicles found in either state will be tagged and towed after 7 days.

The Village also has the option to issue citations to the owner of the vehicle being towed. When an inoperable vehicle is on private property it must be fully enclosed within a garage. Placing a tarp or car cover over a vehicle is not an acceptable alternative.

Burglary Prevention

Burglaries can occur anywhere. A burglary occurs when a person enters a building, residence or vehicle without proper authorization and commits a theft or felony offense while inside. Although Swansea has a very low crime rate these can happen anywhere. Almost all of the burglaries that occur in Swansea involve entry into houses and/or vehicles that have been left unlocked. The following information can help you reduce your chances of being the victim of a burglary.

Safety Tips for Your Residence:

Exterior cameras and an alarm system can really help prevent something bad. Many bad guys look for cameras now and select residences that do not have them. Make sure all exterior doors/windows

are closed and locked when leaving. The vast majority of our burglaries involve doors/windows left unlocked.

Use dead-bolt type locks on exterior doors.

Place a wooden pole or broom handle in sliding glass door tracks to keep the sliding door from opening.

Leave a radio or television on if you are going to be gone for a few hours.

Put some lights on a timer if you will not be returning until after dark.

If you are going to be away for several days, either stop your newspaper delivery or make arrangements for a friend, neighbor or relative to pick up your paper on a daily basis. Don't let the papers accumulate in your yard. Go to our web site and you can complete a form and the police department will conduct vacation checks for you.

Make a list of your valuables (make, model, serial number and value). Keep one copy of the list at home

and store another copy in a safety deposit box or other location in case of a fire.

If you see something suspicious do not hesitate, but call us immediately. Call 911 or the non-emergency number of 233-8114. We will always send an officer to check it out.

Spring In Swansea

Spring Rains Always Bring The Potential For Flooding

Spring in Swansea means the grass is growing, flowers are blooming, and rain is falling. While heavy rain and flooding occur during any season of the year, most of the major floods in our area have occurred during the spring and fall rains. And while only about 60 acres in the Village of Swansea are within the regulated floodplain, many other areas outside the designated floodplain are also susceptible to flooding.

So the Village wants to remind its residents of a few safety tips relating to flooding:

Do not walk through flood waters. Currents are deceptive. Six inches of moving water can knock you off your feet. If you must walk, use a stick to test that ground remains under the water ahead of you.

Do not drive through a flooded area. More people drown in their cars than anywhere else.

Do not drive around barriers, as the road or bridge may be washed out.

Stay away from power lines and electrical wires. The number two flood killer after drowning is electrocution. Report downed power lines to the power company or 911.

Turn off all electrical circuits and gas lines that may come in contact with flood water.

Residents of Swansea can help minimize flooding and the resulting damage by checking with the Building and Zoning Department prior to building on, altering, grading, or placing fill on your property. A permit may be required to ensure that a project is compliant with all codes. Report any suspected illegal building, filling, or dumping to the Village at 618-234-0044.

If your house has flooded in the past or you fear that it may flood in the future, talk to the Village about protecting your house or business. There may be ways to modify your building to minimize flood damage.

Where flooding tends to be shallow, measures such as small floodwalls, regrading the yard, and flood proofing the walls or utilities can be relatively

inexpensive. Where flooding is deep, a building may need to be elevated. Again, be sure to check if permits are required before performing any work.

Even if you're not in the mapped floodplain, your property may be subject to flooding from local drainage. In either case, flood insurance may be a good investment because most homeowners insurance policies do not cover damage caused by surface water flooding. Contact your property insurance agent to see if a flood insurance policy would help you.

If you have questions about your flood hazard you can contact the Building and Zoning Department.

Keep Pollutants Out Of Storm Water. As a reminder don't pour oil, grease, pesticides, or other pollutants down storm drains or into drainage ditches or streams.

Streams and wetlands help moderate flooding and are habitat for fish, frogs, and other species that provide recreation or food. Let's protect them and their homes.

Severe Weather Safety Tips From the Swansea Fire Department

Severe thunderstorm Safety

The majority of the U.S. is at risk for severe weather, which can cause dangerous and sometimes life-threatening conditions. Snowstorms, extreme cold, hurricane force winds, torrential rains and flooding, and lightning can all wreak havoc on our daily schedules. Preparing before a disaster strikes and knowing what to do during and after a storm will help ensure you and your family greatly reduce your risk for injury and damage to your home.



Safety tips

-Develop and practice an evacuation plan ahead of a severe weather event. Include a plan for pets and add any transportation routes and destinations in the plan. Prepare an emergency supplies kit for both family members and pets ahead of time to take with you. Be prepared to evacuate when authorities tell you to do so.

-Stay out of flood waters, if possible, and do not drive into flooded areas. Even water only several inches deep can be dangerous.

-Always assume fallen power lines are energized. Stay away from the area and report any downed lines to authorities immediately.

-Unplug appliances and other electrical items, such as computers and televisions, to prevent damage from surges

caused by lightning strikes.

-If you evacuated, do not return to your home until local authorities say it is safe.

-Plan two ways out of the home in case of an emergency. Clear driveway and front walk of ice and snow. This will provide easy access to your home.


-Make sure your house number can be seen from the street. If you need help, first responders will be able to find you.

Swansea Rotary Club Again Offers Chad Wood Scholarship

The Rotary Club of Swansea annually sponsors scholarships in the memory of Chad Wood, who was a student at Belleville East when he died in a May 9, 2005 automobile accident.

In 2021, the club will award two \$2,000 scholarships, with the competition open to all graduating high school students who reside in the Village of Swansea at the time of the March 26, 2021 application deadline, and/or who have resided in the Village of Swansea for at least three of the past five years immediately prior to the March 26, 2021 application deadline.

Students who expect to graduate from Althoff Catholic High School; Belleville East; Belleville West; Governor French Academy; private or parochial schools in Madison County or St. Clair County, IL; St. Louis City or St. Louis County (MO), and who satisfy the residency requirements as above stated, are eligible, subject to the following qualifications:

- The applicant must be a person of good moral character who has demonstrated a commitment to the concept of community service and volunteerism.
- Each applicant must submit an essay of 350-500 words on a subject

related to Rotary's motto of "Service Above Self."

- The applicant must have attained a GPA of at least 3.0+ at the time of application (if school is on a 4.0 basis) or 4.0+ (if on a 5.0 basis).
- The applicant must submit at least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, clergy member, or other unrelated adult who knows the applicant's interests, work habits and capabilities.
- The application, essay and letter of recommendation must be submitted by mail no later than Friday, March 26, 2021. The envelope must bear a post-mark date of March 26, 2021 or earlier.


