President Mike opened the meeting with Pledge of Allegiance at 7:05 am, followed by discussion of Agenda Items.

Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve 9 January 2021 minutes made by Jim, second by Matt. Motion approved.

Use of Band Shell at Schranz Park: Mark Tessereau, Band Director at Belleville East High School, requests use of band shell at Schranz Park. No set date for event, most likely will choose a weekend in late April or May. After discussion, motion to approve concert, with stipulation that insurance, permits, etc., are provided by the school. Motion to recommend by Barb, second by David. Motion carried.

Disc Golf Pro Shop at Clinton Hills: Three tournaments are scheduled for 2021; the 2 day on the second weekend in October, both 1 day tournaments, in August. The Village will receive a \$200 fee for each use of the course. Fletchers will cover the cost of electric carts.

Girl Scout Fishing Tournament: Request by Amy Huller, Event Coordinator for Girl Scouts Belleville/Swansea Service Unit, to approve fishing tournament at Clinton Hills Park on May 1. After discussion, motion to approve fishing tournament, with the stipulation that all insurance, permits, etc., are provided by the Girl Scouts, by Diane, second by David. Motion carried.

Adult Easter Egg Hunt: Report by Marilyn. Our first year, 2019, in spite of pouring rain, we made \$1000. This year's egg hunt should be especially well attended because of Corvid 19 restrictions for so long. Egg hunt will take place on Saturday, Mar 27. Discussion followed. The Mayor is very uncomfortable with holding event at this time. Members voiced their opinions. It was decided to forego the Easter Egg Hunt this year and choose an event sometime during the summer. David suggested a treasure hunt during the summer as alternative.

Santa House: Mayor likes the idea of moving Santa House to Thompson Center. Both will have permanent wifi.

Memorial Day: Will most likely have our ceremony on May 31<sup>st</sup>. We still have all resources available. We will begin planning.
