

10 April 2021 Swansea Park Board Meeting Minutes

President Mike opened the meeting with Pledge of Allegiance at 7:06 am, followed by discussion of Agenda Items.

Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve 13 March 2021 minutes with the correction of Memorial Day Speaker's name to read Jerry Dallape made by Jonas, second by David. Motion approved.

Pavilion -Clinton Hills: Fletchers expressed interest to purchase the large pavilion overlooking the pond and the bathrooms adjacent to the pavilion. After discussion, all park board members present unanimously agreed that selling the pavilion and bathrooms is not in the best interest of Clinton Hills Conservation Park.

Weekend Park Activity: Rick Tucker received phone call from Republic Services regarding the amount of trash that filled the large dumpster by the Lehr Bldg. Food and greasy items were piled in the dumpster unbagged. Clean-up required two village employees 7 hours to clean up. The renters moved the flags, a few chairs and tables into the storage area behind the kitchen; damage to the floor, table and wall was noted. Discussion followed regarding how to prevent this type of damage.

Adult Treasure Hunt: David came up with the following suggestions: hold event any time from mid-July to beginning of August at Schranz Park. Pre-register online. To follow Corvid guidelines, suggest not more than 40 people at each hunt. Doors open at 6:30; first and second groups can buy 2 egg cartons; third group unlimited cartons and bonus egg ticket. Prizes will be kept in Thompson Bldg. Matt suggested Friday, 8/13. He has lots of gold eggs and can get more to provide for 150 people. Food truck will be open all during the hunt. Unknown at this time whether alcohol will be sold.

Memorial Day Service: Marilyn reported that everything is on track. Marilyn waiting for Eastview Baptist Church to respond. Deacon Art Hampton from Holy Trinity Church to give the invocation. Mike K is MC., Jerry Dallape is speaker, Swansea Firemen will present the Colors. Corvid adjustments will be followed to keep our ceremony safe.
