## Important Changes To Trash and Recycle Program Changes

- Effective 2/27/23 you will no longer need to purchase stickers to pay for your trash collection.
- Instead, you will start receiving a quarterly invoice **directly from Republic Services.** The new rate for trash and recycling collection will be \$17.30 per month.
- If anyone in your household is 62 years of age or older, you are eligible for a senior discounted rate of \$15.57 per month. Please contact Republic Services to apply.
- Every household will receive a 95 gallon cart for trash and also a 95 gallon cart for recycle. **Trash and recycling must be placed in these containers for service.**
- There will be no change to your trash collection schedule.
- Recycling will still be collected the same day as trash, but will be serviced on an every- other- week schedule and remains free. **Please see page 4 for recycling calendar and keep the calendar you receive in the mail from Republic Services for a reference.**

## Questions & Answers

- Q. What do I do with any leftover stickers?  
A. Please take any pre-purchased stickers to City Hall at 1444 Boul Ave and your **Republic Services account will be credited.**
- Q. What do I do with my personal cans and recycling bins?  
A. **You can keep them if you like, or you can set them out empty on your service day and they will be disposed of. Please note, trash and recycling will no longer be collected out of personal cans or bins.**
- Q. I am having difficulty getting these carts to the curb for service. What should I do?  
A. Please contact customer service as we have smaller carts available. If you have a medical condition that prevents you from being able to get your carts to the curb, we can assist with that as well.
- Q. What do I do if I have more trash than will fit in 1-95 gal cart?  
A. Extra trash carts can be leased for an additional \$3.00 per month. Please contact customer service to order.

## Leaf Burning Resumes March 15th

Leaf Burning will resume **March 15th through May 15th on Wednesdays and Saturdays only from 9 AM to 6 PM.** Burning is not allowed on Village streets or within the Village right-of-way. Fires must be attended and kept under control at all times.



Should the weather be excessively windy, conditions be wet, or air forecasted to be unhealthy for sensitive groups (101 – 150) or higher as determined by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency dates above, burning on said dates shall not be permitted. In the event of such conditions, the Village will post its determination on the Village's website, and send a Code Red alert to residents registered for such alerts. However, it shall be incumbent on anyone intending to burn yard waste, to first reference the Village website for any such notice.

While the Village makes this temporary allowance, all residents should consider the impact burning yard waste might have on their neighbors. Those with asthma or other respiratory issues can be significantly affected by smoke.



## Village's Sewer Rate Increase

For over a decade, the Village's sewer rates have remained unchanged, in an effort to run an efficient and cost-effective Waste Water Treatment Plant. With many significant capital projects upcoming, Officials understand that more resources will be required to maintain the plant and the system for the next ten years. After completing a six-month Rate Study, the Village has passed an ordinance increasing sewer rates as follows:



## ***Swansea Rotary Club Again Offers Chad Wood Scholarship***

The Rotary Club of Swansea annually sponsors scholarships in the memory of Chad Wood, who was a student at Belleville East when he died in a May 9, 2005 automobile accident.

In 2023, the club will award three \$2,500 scholarships, with the competition open to all graduating high school students who **currently** reside in the Village of Swansea at the time of the March 20, 2023 application deadline, and/or who have resided in the Village of Swansea for at least three of the past five years immediately prior to the March 20, 2023 application deadline.

Students who expect to graduate from Althoff Catholic High School; Belleville East; Belleville West; Governor French Academy; private or parochial schools in Madison County or St. Clair County, IL; St. Louis City or St. Louis County (MO), and who satisfy the residency requirements as above stated, are eligible, subject to the following qualifications:

- The applicant must be a person of good moral character who has demonstrated a commitment to the concept of community service and volunteerism.
- Each applicant must submit an essay of 350-500 words on a subject related to Rotary's motto of "*Service Above Self.*"
- The applicant must have attained a GPA of at least 3.0+ at the time of application (if school is on a 4.0 basis) or 4.0+ (if on a 5.0 basis).
- The applicant must submit at least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, clergy member, or other unrelated adult who knows the applicant's interests, work habits and capabilities.
- The application, essay and letter of recommendation must be submitted by mail not later than March 20, 2023. The envelope must bear a post-mark date of March 20, 2023 or earlier.

**Application must be complete at the time of receipt. Failure to follow instructions and/or an incomplete application will not be considered.**
