ORDINANCE NO. 2007

AN ORDINANCE AMMENDING SECTION 115.07 WITHING CHAPTER 115: LIQUOR CONTROL

WHEREAS, the Village of Swansea recognizes that the issuance and regulation or alcoholic liquor licenses directly impacts the health, safety, and welfare of the community. It is therefore the intent of the President of the Board of Trustees to maintain appropriate local control over the number and type of licenses issued within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the availability of alcoholic liquor licenses shall be determined based upon considerations including, but not limited to, the character of surrounding neighborhoods, public safety resources, the adequacy of existing licensed establishments to serve the public, and the overall economic and social interests of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Accordingly, the President of the Board of Trustees retain the authority to determine, from time to time, the number of licenses in each classification that may be issued, ensuring that such determinations align with the Villages regulatory objectives and community standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SWANSEA, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: SECTION 115.07 CLASSIFICATION; FEES SHOULD BE AMMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

(C) Class C licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquor on the premises specified for consumption on the premises where sold, as well as other retail sales of liquor during the hours specified in § 115.25 of this chapter. The annual fee for such license shall be \$600 for any for-profit establishment, and \$500 for any not-for-profit establishment. There shall be no more than nine Class C licenses issued.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions or applications of the Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.




